BIBB COUNTY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT PLOT PLAN REQUIREMENTS

On a boundary/topographic survey prepared by a Georgia licensed surveyor or an enlarged property/topographic map overlay prepared by the county's mapping department of the subject property, provide the following information:

- 1. Show location of structure(s) with dimensions and distances to property lines.
- 2. Show all building setbacks required by Macon Bibb County Planning and Zoning Department.
- 3. Show driveway(s) and dimensions.
- 4. Show lowest finished floor elevation (FFE) of structure. If structure is adjacent to drainage ditch, maintain FFE two feet above top of ditch bank.
- 5. Show existing contours (shown as solid lines) at two-foot intervals.
- 6. Show proposed contours (shown as dashed lines) at two-foot intervals.
- 7. Indicate proposed site grading to assure positive drainage away from all structures using slope arrows.
- 8. Show all right-of-ways and easements showing existing drainage ditches and/or existing structures (i.e. pipes, manholes, yard inlets, etc.). Include pipe size, length and type of material. <u>Under no circumstances will construction be allowed on easements</u>.
- 9. All proposed drainage structures must be designed by a Georgia licensed professional engineer, land surveyor or landscape architect.
- 10. Show street address and subdivision name and lot number.
- 11. Show owner's name, address, date, daytime phone number and owner's signature.
- 12. Include this certification: The proposed drainage modifications will not adversely affect properties upstream or downstream of subject property.
- 13. The plot plan preparer must sign the plan (and affix his seal, if he is a licensed professional).
